Significant Events: Fire is active in higher terrain with continuous heavy shrub fuels and Pinyon Pine - Juniper mix. Firing operations are continuing on lower slopes in grass/shrub fuels. High temps and very low RH, with strong SW winds are providing conditions for large fire growth. Spread is primarily to the NE in higher terrain above 4500' on interior portions of the fire. Successful firing operations are being conducted at lower elevations in lighter fuels on the NE side of the fire.

Remarks:

Planned Actions: Use direct and indirect attack operations to minimize impact to values at risk including: the Pinto Valley and Carlotta mines, and mine infrastructures, the Tonto National Monument, 115kv powerlines and the major 500kv power line serving the Phoenix area, transportation corridors, commercial property, private residences, recreation areas, riparian waterways, threatened and endangered species (Mexican Spotted Owl) and Sonoran Desert ecosystem.

Firing operations were conducted around the Cross P ranch northeast to Hwy 188 and continued along Hwy 188 just the northwest of the Tonto National Monument in an effort to lessen the impact of the approaching fire front as it approaches the highway. A 30 acre spot fire occurred at the Windy Hill campground turnoff along Hwy 188 and was quickly contained and mopped up. Crews are also doing point protection and have finished prep work on commercial and private property from the Roosevelt Lake Dam southeast along Hwy 188 to the Hwy 288 junction.

Crews have completed prepping around the Pinto Valley Mine, Carlotta Mine and mine infrastructures. A hoselay has been put in along the West side of the property at the Pinto Valley Mine in the Pinto Creek drainage. The incident management team has designated a fire liaison from the structure protection group for the Pinto Valley Mine. The intent is to keep mine personnel informed of fire activity and strategic management actions that could affect mining operations.

The fire on the south and west flanks is now being put into patrol/monitor status but could still impact a major transportation artery (Hwy 88), high voltage power lines, Horse Mesa Dam, private businesses, private residences, ranch properties, numerous recreation areas and Sonoran Desert Habitat. Plans for rehabilitation in these areas are now being made.

A night shift has been implemented to keep fire from crossing Hwy 188 and to protect all values at risk.

Critical needs for (3) IHC1 and (3) HC2IA will be used to replace crews that have timed out.

Rational for extended containment date timeframe: the nature of the cinder hills area is unique and far different than all other areas of the Coconino National Forest in relation to fire behavior and conditions relating to fire behavior. Due to the very porous soil (small diameter cinders) combined with extremely windy conditions equates to large amounts of combustible material being buried by wind-blown cinders. This creates an environment that can take weeks to finally consume all of the buried combustible material, thus a lengthy containment timeframe.
